PHOTOGRAPHIC COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Style: The overall theme of the competition is 'Strange Bird' meets 'Nude Food'. Further details relating to these terms can be found on the GBWT website (granitebeltwinecountry.com.au). Nude Food, as a concept, relates to food that is as nature intended – fresh from the region and in season. The images may be fun or modestly suggestive (e.g. the Calendar Girls movie case) but they should not be submitted if they could reasonably be considered in bad taste. If appropriate, please incorporate elements that are features of this region, such as granite, winter frosts, spring fruit trees, vintage picking and refer to the monthly themes listed below.

Themes: Entries need not be limited by the following themes but they should be used as a guide.

JANUARY – berries...FEBRUARY – vintage wines...MARCH – apples...APRIL – pears... MAY – Olives and savouries...JUNE – green vegetables...JULY – brass monkey...AUGUST – mushrooms and meat...SEPTEMBER – new release wines...OCTOBER – sweet things
NOVEMBER – cherries ... DECEMBER – stone fruit.

Specifications: Photographs to be in landscape format and saved electronically as a jpeg. For reproduction to A4 size, scanned image resolution to be at 300dpi. File names on images should be saved by month name onto a disk.

Participants may be amateur or professional photographers but must be over 18. Individuals may submit more than one entry per month and are encouraged to submit for any/all of the twelve months.

Submissions should be on disk clearly marked with the photographer's name, address, telephone number and other contact details as well as month or months entered. Please send disks to: GBWT Calendar Competition, 157 High Street, Stanthorpe.

Closing Date: Wednesday 20th May 2009.

Terms:

- All images must be the work of the entrant listed on the disk.
- All winning photographs may be used by Granite Belt Wine and Tourism to promote the region at no charge to GBWT.
- It is the photographer's responsibility to obtain appropriate permission from any people who appear in their images and, by submitting an entry, the entrant acknowledges that such permission has been obtained.
- Please keep a copy of your entry. Disks will not be returned.
- The judging panel reserves the right to accept or reject entries.
- The judges' decisions will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Prizes:

- **Overall champion** – dinner for two at the GBWT member restaurant of your choice PLUS 1 dozen mixed local wines. First place recognition will be printed in the 2010 calendar.
- **All other winners** – all photographers whose work is chosen for the remaining 11 pages will receive a selection of six Granite Belt wines and will have their name printed with their photo in the calendar.
