WHAT IS IT ?

It's a Wall of Faces which, with your help, will be created in Augusta.

WHAT'S THE FORMAT ?

One hundred faces will be placed randomly but creatively, on the south-facing wall of the Augusta Hotel parking area, in the following categories and ratios:

local identities (from Augusta and within the AMR Shire) - 50%
state identities - 25%: national identities - 15%: world identities - 10%.

HOW WILL IT HAPPEN ?

Interested parties - individuals, clubs, schools, associations, local government, banks and businesses - are invited to submit nominations for the Wall of Faces.

WHO CAN I NOMINATE ?

Before nominating personalities for selection on the Wall of Faces, we ask that you give serious thought as to the significance and achievements the nominated person/s have made, not only to Augusta, but also the south-west region, the state, the country and the world in such fields as the arts, science, politics, community, education, indigenous, sport, exploration, settlement.

The brief is, quite simply, personalities for posterity.

*Augusta, with its stunning coastal and riverine environment,
is a town that sits very comfortably on Planet Earth as
an undisputed destination of superb natural attractions.
The various categories chosen for the selection of notable
people for the Wall of Faces, reflect this concept.*

AUGUSTA'S WALL OF FACES (cont'd)

Costs for the Wall of Faces will involve the reproduction of images, to a portrait-format, measuring approximately 450mm x 600mm. There will be engineering costs for affixing the images to the wall, which will need sizing and painting.

Funds for the project will be pursued from various sources and it is expected that there will be enthusiastic support for the Wall of Faces.

You may nominate as many characters as you wish, for selection on the Wall of Faces, one for each submission, and each one to be accompanied by a minimum of 100 words describing why you think your nomination/s should be included on the wall.

A nomination fee of \$15 should be included with your first submission but any further nominations you may wish to submit will be free of charge.

Donations, of any amount, towards the project would be appreciated.

The organisers offer individual sponsorship of a nominated personality, at a cost of \$200. Names of such sponsors will be publicly acknowledged on the wall.

In the event that a nominated image is not in the final selection for the Wall of Faces, all monies (excluding the nomination fee of \$15) will be refunded to the nominator, unless otherwise directed.

When lodging submissions for the Wall of Faces, a photograph, painting or drawing of the person nominated would be appreciated together with the relevant permission for its use on the wall (*see submission form*).
