

to Tulip Time's 54th
Festival. With its beginnings in 1961 and only 500
tulips, the Festival has grown into one of Australia's
premier floral festivals with 100,000 tulip bulbs,
20,000 annuals and over 65,000 visitors into the
Southern Highlands each year. Tulip Time is proud
to be a major fundraising platform for this year's
partnered charity Guide Dogs NSW/ACT.

# CORBETT GARDENS 100YRS

This year we celebrate Corbett Gardens official opening 100 years ago, with the gardens being the major site for the Tulip Time festival for the past 54 years. For many years Ada Corbett worked, cleared and planted trees on the empty corner block near her home in Bowral. She pushed hard for the land, then known as 'Deadmeads' or 'Denmeads Paddock' to be turned into a public park. In 1911 a £350 grant was received from the Department of Lands and clearing of the land began. Shrubs for the new garden were donated by the Botanical Gardens in Sydney and a bandstand was also erected.

The gardens were officially opened on December 16, 1914 by Mr FA Badgery MLA and the rotunda opened by the Mayor of Bowral Municipal Council. Ald E Boardman.

A da Corbett knew that her little corner garden would make a lot of people happy, but she had no idea that it would one day be known around the country for its beauty drawing thousands of visitors every year.

# FAQ's

Q. How do you time the tulips flowering at Tulip Time?

- A. How and when tulips flower is determined by soil temperature. We know from experience that the best time to plant tulips in the Southern Highlands is around Anzac Day in April. However we can't control the exact flowering date so we can make sure a mix of early, mid and late flowering tulips extend the flowering season.
- Q. Where do the bulbs come from?
- A. Bulbs come from Tasmania and Victoria. 100,000 bulbs is a huge order to fill, so two separate suppliers are required.
- Q. How long does it take to plant the bulbs?
- This year it took twelve gardeners ten days to plant the bulbs.
- Q. Do you store the bulbs in the fridge?
- A. We're unable to refrigerate such a large quantity of bulbs so have to plant them quickly once they arrive. However our growers do keep the bulbs chilled, which is something home gardeners can do a month before planting. Just remember not to mistake them for an onion.
